Terminology	Definition
Integrated First Year Courses	Students must take 48 UOC of the integrated first year courses.
Commerce Co-op Specialisation	A sequence of approved courses (84UOC) in an approved Co-op discipline stream offered by the UNSW Business School, containing at least 18UOC at level 3. For majority of majors, students will complete 42 UOC in specified disciplinary courses outside the core and 36 UOC Industry Training.)
Industrial Training Experience	These courses account for 36 UOC. Students complete 3 industrial training experience courses within the area of their co-op scholarship, with each course worth 12 UOC.
Business School Electives	Students must complete Business School Electives to complete a minimum of 132UOC of courses within the Business School. Students are free to use these UOC to complete a second Commerce major or minor, however they need to be mindful of the program level 1 limit when making their selection. GEN courses cannot count as Business School Electives.
Free Electives <u>OR</u> Second Major <u>OR</u> Minor	Students can take up to a maximum of 48 UOC of the following courses. Students are free to use these UOC to complete courses from any Faculty or to complete a second Major or a Minor. However, they need to be mindful of the program limit on Level 1 courses (72 UOC) when making their selection. <u>NOTE: GEN coded courses cannot count as a Free Elective.</u> Student undertaking certain double majors may not have any free electives.
