

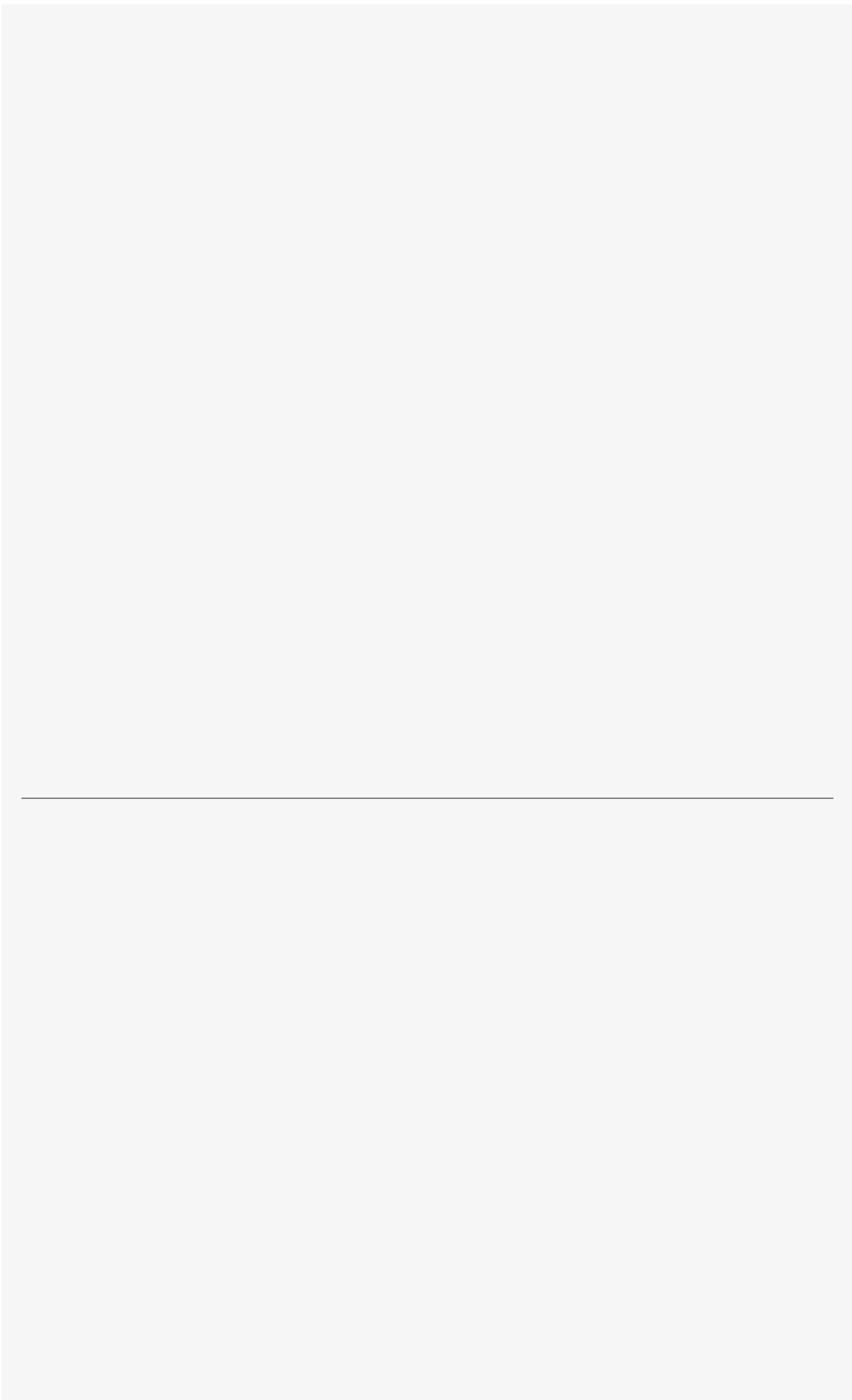

The Centre staff are continuing to work hard, albeit largely from home under restrictions due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The skeleton staff, working in the Centre and Hubs, are safe and exercising all the social distancing and hand washing practices. The Centre's work now includes assisting NSW Health and local health districts in responding to the pandemic. For example, some staff have been involved in contact tracing and helping services to implement rapid changes such as the use of telehealth. All our other work continues, although it has been more challenging to deal with health service providers because of the increased demands under the COVID-19 pandemic.
