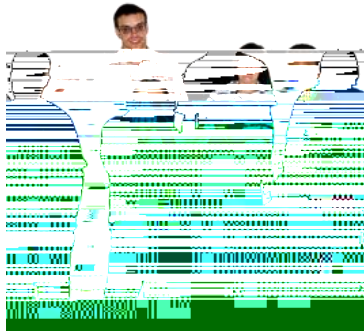


About our study

What Family Advocacy does



Families and people with disability are supported to advocate.



People with disability tell their families what they want and do not want.



Their families listen to them.



Families support the person to enjoy a full life in the community.



Families support the person to fix things when it goes wrong.

How Family Advocacy supports families



Families use information from Family Advocacy and other families.



They use this information to speak up about things.



Families feel stronger when they work together with others.



They become part of a group of families who support the rights and interests of people with disability.



Family Advocacy help families learn from each other about how to support their family members.
